

## In Cordova on prevention in agriculture

The goal of the event was to promote the strategy of Vision Zero of the International Social Security Association (ISSA) which marks as its priority the reduction in the number of accidents and occupational diseases to zero. During the event discussions were held on the newest achievements and good practices concerning the various aspects of prevention in agriculture.

The Colloquium was an excellent opportunity for the experts from all over the world to exchange experiences and introduce new ideas concerning the actions which contribute to the decrease in the number of accidents and occupational illnesses. Among the
