Organisational structure:

Inspection du Travail et des Mines, established by the Act of 22 May 1902, is subordinate to the Ministry of Labour, Employment and the Social and Solidarity Economy. Following a reorganisation conducted in April 2015, it was divided into 7 departments dealing with investigation of accidents at work, international affairs, social dialogue, inspections, supervision and prevention in construction, and companies subject to authorisations.

The Inspectorate also operates a help center.

Apart from its main office in Strassen, ITM has three units in: Diekirch, Esch-sur-Alzette and Wiltz. Labour inspectors are supported in the field by the customs service and conduct joint investigations of accidents at work or inspections following a complaint.

Areas of activity:

The main areas of activity are as follows: supervision of compliance with the labour law (including individual and collective labour relations), regulations on health and safety at work and social legislation, inspection of employment legality, juvenile labour, supervision of high-risk companies, mediation in labour disputes. Additionally, ITM conducts extensive preventive and counselling activity.

Our cooperation:

In line with Directive 96/71/EC, the National Labour Inspectorate, as a liaison institution, cooperates with ITM in Luxembourg in the framework of mutual exchange of information on the posting of workers.

The Agreement:

The Agreement on cooperation and exchange of information between the National Labour Inspectorate in the Republic of Poland and the Inspectorate of Labour and Mines in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg - concluded in June 2010.
